

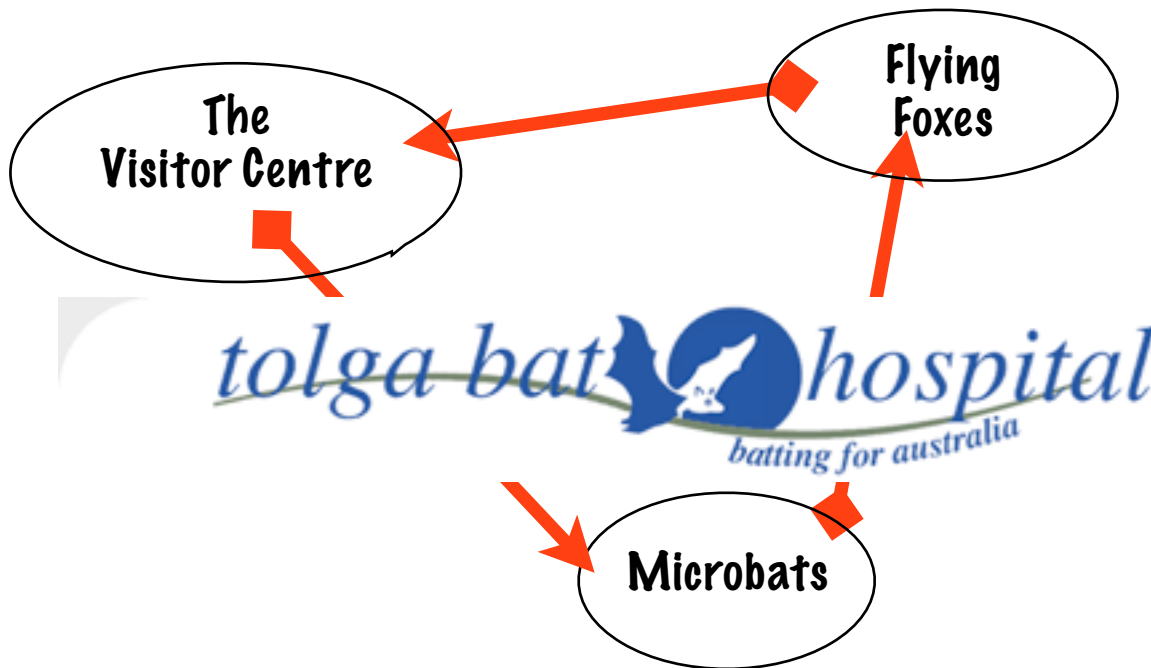
BAT-TASTIC OPEN DAY
